

# HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

**Do you have a plan for your pets  
should disaster strike?**

## **Prepare Ahead:**

**Identification:** Make sure your pet is wearing a collar with identification, a rabies tag, and the information is legible. Talk to your vet about **microchipping** and ensuring registry information is current.

**Know where to go:** If you have to leave the area, or are unable to stay at home, have a plan of where to go with your pets.

Keep a list of pet friendly hotels or boarding facilities handy.

Keep a list and contact information of **emergency veterinary hospitals** both locally and in areas you may travel to, should a medical need arise.

**Routinely check your emergency  
kit to ensure it is well  
stocked & not expired.**

## **Assemble an Emergency Kit:**

- ▶ 3-5 days worth of food
- ▶ Pet medications and medical records
- ▶ Bottled water
- ▶ Extra pet food/water dishes and litter boxes for cats
- ▶ Extra leash, harness, and/or carrier
- ▶ Pet first aid kit
- ▶ A picture of you and your pet together
